TLT's Net-Zero Journey


- TLT's 2040 net-zero target verified by SBTi
- Move to green offices
- Circular Facilities and IT management
- 'TLT World' fully flexible approach to work
- 100% renewable energy across all offices
- EVs leasing scheme



TLT's journey to net-zero GHG emissions by FY2040

- Includes our near-term target, reduction of absolute scope 3 emissions by 47% by FY2030 from FY2019 base
- This means reducing TLT's Supply Chain emissions

Challenges:

- Services Suppliers are the biggest supplier base for TLT
 - Calculating these emissions is difficult

Next milestone towards sustainable TLT's Supply Chain

- **To improve Supply Chain Sustainability, it needs to be measured first**
 - 20% of suppliers 80% of emissions
 - Currently applying spend-based method, focusing on top 50 Suppliers
 - Utilising sustainability software
 - Engaging with Suppliers, and
 - Receiving emissions data provided by Suppliers (challenges availability of data, accuracy of data)
